

## Questions for John 13 – Women’s Bible Study for 7/14/24

1. Jesus knew His time or His hour had come (1)? See John 12:23-27
2. Who would customarily wash the feet of visitors in the home?
3. In Luke 22:23, what were the disciples discussing when they entered the upper room? What characteristic does Jesus portray in the washing of the disciples’ feet (5)?
4. Why did Peter object to Jesus washing his feet? Wasn’t foot washing customary in that day? (8)
5. In v11 what is Jesus saying when he says “You are not all clean.”?
6. What characteristics is Jesus exhibiting as an “example” to His disciples (14-17)
7. In Psa 41:9 and v18 – what is meant by “has lifted his heel against Me”?
8. In V20 – what is meant when Jesus says “he who receives whomever I send receives Me; and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me”?
9. Who is the disciple that Jesus loved? (V23) What else do we know about this disciple?
10. What is the place of honor at a host’s table? Who was seated there and how do you know? (V25)
11. What’s the significance of dipping bread in wine and giving it to someone at the table? What was Jesus showing the recipient of the bread/wine sop? Could Judas have repented at that point in time?
12. What series of events were set in action when Judas departed from Jesus? (31)
13. Why does Jesus refer to his disciples as “little children” (33)
14. How must the disciples have felt hearing Jesus was going away? (33, 36)
15. What is the “new commandment” Jesus gives the disciples? (34,35)
16. How precise was Jesus’ answer to Peter, “the rooster shall not crow till you have denied Me three times?” (38)
